Goals:

1. Appropriate hygiene prior to beginning.
2. Wearing of gloves, hat, and apron.
3. Listening skills as there are lots of directions given before commencing with the chocolate making.
4. Pouring of chocolate into molds, making of truffles and other candy.
5. Weighing the candy to insure that it does not exceed 1 pound.
6. Using the conveyer belt and other utensils in the chocolate making area.
7. Patience and turn taking as all items must be shared.
